So did you play on a field for the state tournament that was not satisfactory? Were there fences for fast pitch? (190-210 feet) Were there dug outs? Did they treat the baseball and softball fields the same.? Please put your remarks in writing and send them to Sue so that they can be relayed next season to the Baseball Softball Committee. If there were inequities please write to the MHSAA Baseball/ Softball Committee in care of Randy Allen. We as an association must become pro active to make sure fields for tournament are the best possible. If you have a good field please contact your Athletic Director to apply to host the games. Remember when the committee decides which fields will host tournaments, we must give the tournament to schools that apply and want to do the extra work.

Miss Softball 2007

How does a player become Miss Softball. This is a award that was established to honor a career in Softball. The committee made up of former coaches from around the state view statistics from a players four years and compare averages per innings played. It is important to note that a player did not have to play varsity for four years but have good averages. This year the committee selected Lauren Memmer or Lakeland as the Pitcher and Brittany Merchant from Wayland as the Position Player.

Division 1 coaches and players have seen Lauren a lot since she has guided Lakeland to two straight runner up state championships. She has accumulated many awards on her way through high school. Lauren has been first team all state for three years. Along with those honors she was also all district, region, all county, all metro and the teams MVP. Lauren along with her team set a record in the state with the most wins for a career with 144 wins.

Lauren compiled a slew of statistics over her four years as a varsity player. She faced 3584 batters and struck out 1036 while only walking 32 batters. Her total ERA was a 0.31 while allowing only 132 runs with only 40 of them earned in her career. Lauren is also a threat as a batter as her batting average for all four years averaged .419.

Lauren will be taking her softball skills to the University of Detroit Mercy next fall.

Brittini Merchant of Wayland has also played four years on the varsity. She will be taking her talents next fall to Central Michigan University. Brittini accounted for 187 runs for the Wayland team. She accounted for 176 RBI's ;23 doubles; and 7 homeruns. While batting in the third position on the team she stole 87 bases and received 53 free passes. Career statistics account for a batting average of .464 and a field average of .925,

Brittini will be missed next year in Wayland not only for her Softball skills but also in other sports she participated in. She was a four year letter winner in Basketball, three years in Volleyball, two years on the bowling team and played number one singles on the tennis team.

All State Awards

Many thanks go out to those of you who worked on the all state selection procedure. Thirty two regional representatives met at Battle Creek Central on Friday. We must give special thanks to Tracy Allen from Battle Creek Central for arranging the food and rooms for us. It is very difficult to sort through all the forms and select the 30 first team members, 30 Honorable Mention players and a Miss Softball representative from each class. Any coach who wanted to know if their player made the teams was given the opportunity to call their regional representative on Saturday or Sunday. This procedure was to avoid other summer coaches from telling your players they had made all state. So if you were waiting for a call from your regional chairman and did not get one, you were supposed to call them.

Another note dealing with all state procedures. We really need each coach to completely fill out the forms for All State. This includes all the statistical data, the addresses, and the teams schedule which needs to appear on the back of the form. It is extremely difficult for us to deal with your player without all of this information.

So thanks to the hours that regional and divisional reps put in to select the all state team.
